Qualification Criteria:

1. Alabama resident
2. Recipient must be pursuing a degree at Alabama universities & colleges in agriculture or related degree area with the intent on entering the fruit and vegetable production industry.
3. The applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student
4. GPA of 2.5

Selection Criteria:

1. The Alabama Farmers Agricultural Foundation scholarship committee will review all applications, with advice of the AFVGA board, and award the scholarship.
2. Scholarship will be awarded based on competitive review of all applications taking into consideration each student's academic achievement, leadership skills, accomplishments, and statement of goals.
3. Application deadline is January 31

Scholarship Criteria:

1. A gift of \$2,000 will be given to the applicant selected.
2. Award winners are eligible to apply for the award in future years.
3. Gift funds are designed to assist with educational related needs incurred by students enrolling in or attending universities & colleges.
4. Recommendation letters can be sent with the application
